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Dr. Wang received her medical doctor's degree from Peking University. She completed her research training as a visiting scholar at Radboud University in the Netherlands. Her research interests include fungal immunology and genetic susceptibility. She has discovered the pathogenic genes for a variety of severe cutaneous fungal infections, including CARD9 deficiency causing phaeohyphomycosis. She has been awarded 9 national or provincial grants as a principal investigator, and has been recruited to "The Ten Thousand Young People Talent Program" "Young Talent Lifting Project" of China. She received the second prize of Beijing Science and Technology Award, and has 45 SCI-indexed publications in key academic journals, including *Journal of Clinical Investigation*, *Lancet Infectious Diseases*, and *Journal of Allergy and Clinical Immunology*, as first or corresponding author.
